(for current 6th Graders ONLY)

Step 1: Complete Sierra Vista Middle School's Online Elective Selection Process

1. Access Sierra Vista Middle School's website to access the elective course descriptions:

2. Read over Elective Options for 2020-21 (which includes a description of each elective) and review the presentations posted on the website.
3. Access the **Elective Selection Form for current 6th graders**: <https://forms.gle/7c6FqXHyUm4bRG6o9>
4. Complete the form
 - Fill in all necessary information
 - The Email Address required at the top should be a parent's email address
 - Select your elective(s) based on your order of preference (please make 3 different choices).

Step 2: Electives (Course Prerequisites and/or Required Signature)

- A prerequisite is a condition of enrollment that students are required to meet to demonstrate readiness for enrollment in a course or program. The following elective courses have prerequisites that must be met in order to enroll (please refer to the course description page for more details): Photojournalism, Video Production, and Science Olympiad.

Step 3: Submit Form to complete the process

- Parent types their name that they agree with the elective choices of their child.
- Press "Submit"
- The Elective Selection Form **MUST** be completed by *Friday, April 24th by 2:00pm*

Information regarding Extended (Zero Period) PE:

Students who selected a qualifying elective (music), intervention class, or leadership are eligible to submit a request for zero period PE. If interested in Extended Day PE (also known as Zero period PE), please **fill out the form** below and email it in DianaAustin@iusd.org by **JUNE 5, 2020** by 2:00pm. You must email a copy of [this form](#) by the due date to be considered for Extended Day PE. This form serves to express interest and does not guarantee placement. Students who receive placement in Extended Day PE will be notified on Registration Day August 12 on their student course list. Students must attend Extended Day PE as they would any other class during the regular school day. Excess absences and/or tardies could result in dismissal from the class, and therefore dismissal of their second elective. Extended Day PE allows students to enroll in a second elective. Extended Day PE runs Monday through Thursday 7:05am - 7:55am. [Extended Day PE Form](#)
